



DIRECTIONS to Heron Hall at the Laguna Environmental Center

The Laguna Environmental Center is a site where visitors come to learn more about the Laguna de Santa Rosa, a Wetland of International Importance. It is home to **Great Blue Heron Hall** which is a meeting space and education center for the Laguna de Santa Rosa Foundation. Heron Hall is also rented out for meetings, conferences, workshops, and retreats, bringing in revenue for the non-profit Foundation. The restored 1872 white farmhouse with palm trees in front is the Laguna Foundation's office.

LOCATION: The Laguna Environmental Center is located on historic Stone Farm, a City of Santa Rosa property along the Laguna near northeast Sebastopol, **at the corner of Occidental Road and Sanford Road**. The address is **900 Sanford Road, Santa Rosa, CA 95401**.

NOTE!!! DO NOT USE GOOGLE MAPS OR MAPQUEST TO FIND IT, as online directions usually guide people to nearby Bravo Toro Lane, but it is a dead-end road and there is no access to Heron Hall or the Laguna Environmental Center from there!

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: From Hwy 101, take Hwy 12 West towards Sebastopol (Go 3.4 miles) At the first streetlight, turn right on Fulton Road, then take the first immediate left onto Occidental Road (Go straight on Occidental Rd. 3.2 miles). Turn right on Sanford Road, and the Laguna Foundation driveway is the first on the right.

PLEASE DRIVE VERY VERY SLOWLY on our dirt road to avoid dust. Thank you!

Weekday Hours: Monday-Friday, 9am-5pm

Stop by for a visit and take a self-guided tour. The site is wheelchair accessible. No dogs allowed please, only service dogs. During the week, Heron Hall is often used for meetings and trainings. Call ahead to see if the hall will be open if you want to view the art exhibit and gift shop, (707) 527-9277, ext. 107.
