

DIRECTIONS to Heron Hall at the Laguna Environmental Center

The Laguna Environmental Center is a site where visitors come to learn more about the Laguna de Santa Rosa, a Wetland of International Importance. It is home to **Great Blue Heron Hal**l, a meeting space and education center for the Laguna de Santa Rosa Foundation. The restored 1872 white farmhouse with palm trees in front is the Laguna Foundation's administrative office.

LOCATION: The Laguna Environmental Center is located on historic Stone Farm, a City of Santa Rosa property along the Laguna near northeast Sebastopol, at the corner of Occidental Road and Sanford Road. The address is **900 Sanford Road**, Santa Rosa, CA **95401**.

NOTE – Do not use Google Maps or Mapquest to find it, as online directions usually guide people to nearby Bravo Toro Lane, but it is a dead-end road and there is no access to Heron Hall or the Laguna Environmental Center from there!

DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

- From Hwy 101, take Hwy 12 West towards Sebastopol (Go 3.4 miles)
- At the first streetlight, turn right on Fulton Road, then take the first immediate left onto Occidental Road (Go straight on Occidental Rd. 3.2 miles).
- Turn right on Sanford Road, and then the first right is the Laguna Foundation driveway.

PLEASE DRIVE VERY SLOWLY on our dirt road to avoid dust (during the dry season). Thank you!

No dogs allowed please, only service dogs.

Regular Schedule: Monday-Friday, 9am-5pm - come by for a visit and self-guided tour. The site is wheelchair accessible. During the week, Heron Hall is often used for meetings and trainings. Call ahead to see if the hall will be open if you want to view the art exhibit and gift shop, (707) 527-9277, ext. 107.

Laguna Environmental Center Special Event Open Houses - Learn about the natural and cultural history of the Laguna de Santa Rosa and historic Stone Farm on a guided tour. Come by for the beautiful views and birdwatching from the observation deck. Bring a picnic! Enjoy our gift shop and a nature-oriented art exhibit in Great Blue Heron Hall.
